Classes 10th and 12th will have no half yearly examination; instead, they will have two preboards. After the first preboard there will be an individual meeting of every student along with their parents with the principal.

4. ENHANCED EXTRACURRICULAR OPPORTUNITIES: We believe in the importance of holistic development and will offer a variety of extracurricular activities and enrichment programs to complement classroom learning and provide students with

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opportunities to explore their interests, talents, and passions.

- Students will be asked to sign up for learning a new skill during the activity periods. Learning a new skill, whether it be dance, music, drama, karate, drawing, or painting, is an enriching endeavour that can enhance the students' life in numerous ways. Each of these skills offers unique benefits and opportunities for personal growth, creativity, and physical health.
- 5. <u>GAMES AND SPORTS</u>: The incorporation of games and sports into the school curriculum supports the development of healthier, well-rounded individuals who are better equipped to face the challenges of the future. With the widespread availability of smartphones and access to social media platforms, we are witnessing a growing concern regarding children's excessive use and potential addiction to cell phones and social media.

In connection with this I would like to draw your attention to children's excessive use of smart phones and other electronic gadgets. There are proven facts that smartphone addiction in children develop anxiety, low self-esteem, addiction, sleep disturbances, eye problems, troubles with the nervous system and many other behavioural problems.

The school will not be forming WhatsApp groups for classes; WhatsApp broadcast messages will reach you on WhatsApp individually whenever any information has to be given to you urgently. No class notes or PDFs will be sent to you through WhatsApp. Be very clear about the fact that your kid does not need a cell phone for his/her studies. Teachers are in the school to teach them. Notes will be given in the school. Let that not be an excuse for your kid to use a smartphone.

11. STRICT PROHIBITION ON PARENTS FOR SENDING CHILDREN TO SCHOOL TEACHERS FOR TUITION: This is to ensure that teachers concentrate their efforts on classroom teaching rather than private tuition. This policy aims to equalize learning opportunities for all students, regardless of their socio-economic background.
